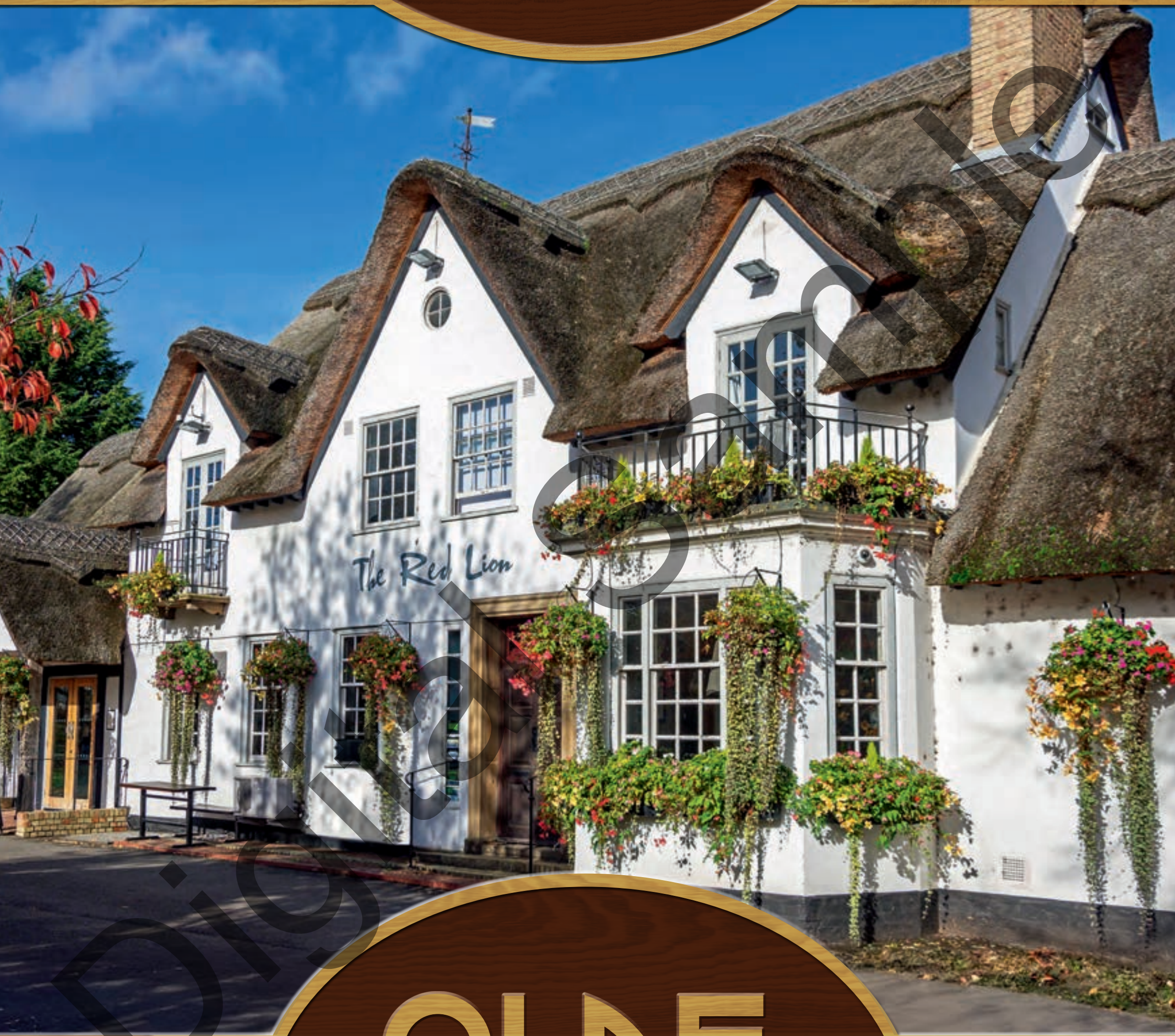

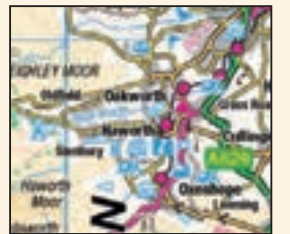

BLACK BULL, Haworth, West Yorkshire

Situated next to the church at the top of Haworth's steep cobbled Main Street, the Black Bull dates back to the 16th century when it was a coaching inn, later becoming a meeting place for Freemasons. It is said to be haunted by the ghost of Patrick Branwell Brontë, brother of the literary Brontë sisters who lived at the Parsonage in the 19th century - he was known to visit the pub a bit too often.

THE RED LION, Grantchester, Cambridgeshire

Set in the peaceful scenic village of Grantchester near Cambridge, this attractive thatched pub is close to Grantchester Meadows alongside the River Cam. It is a popular riverside stroll or even a punt ride away from the city centre. The Red Lion's foundations are from 1777 when it was called the Axe & Saw, but the present building dates from 1936. There are log fires, a large beer garden and a terrace.

THE CHAIN LOCKER, Falmouth, Cornwall

Forming part of the historic quayside, the Chain Locker is one of Falmouth's oldest buildings, overlooking Custom House Quay, the River Fal and the Carrick Roads sailing waters. In the 17th century it was the haunt of sailors manning the Falmouth Steam Packet service, where fast steamships delivered mail across the world. The waterfront inn has balconies and a terrace, with views over Falmouth Harbour.

THE BEAR INN, Llandovery, Carmarthenshire

Painted bold orange, with colourful flowers in wood containers outside, this former coaching inn was a stop on the way from London to West Wales and Ireland. There is evidence of this in its cobbled courtyard, the archway to the stables and the bell-pulls used by travellers. Llandovery is a market town with a history of cattle droving, weekly livestock markets and the remains of a 13th century castle.

BLEEDING WOLF, Scholar Green, Stoke-on-Trent

Built in 1936, this is one of three similarly constructed 'roadhouse' pubs built in the 1930s for Robinsons Brewery of Stockport. It has a Vernacular Revival design, and retains its unusual curved thatched roof, original wood panelled interior, decorative tiling and stained glass. The curious name arises from a legend in which King John rewarded a local forester with land for saving him from a wounded wolf.

TRAVELLERS REST, Glenridding, Cumbria

A welcome sight for weary walkers after descending Helvellyn, this small low-beamed and wood-panelled pub stands close to the fellside, near footpaths up the mountain on a steep road, in the village of Glenridding. At the southern end of Ullswater, Glenridding has a pier for the Ullswater steamers and is popular with walkers. It was once the centre of the lead mining industry at the Greenside Lead Mine.

OLD BEAMS INN, Ibsley, Hampshire

Originally a small, thatched roadside inn, possibly dating from the 11th century, this country pub has been extended over many years. Constructed in a Tudor style, with rendered stone walls beneath a pitched thatched roof, it retains many original features such as an inglenook fireplace and exposed beams. It is situated on the A338 between Ringwood and Fordingbridge, on the edge of the New Forest.

CROSS KEYS, Washington, Tyne and Wear

Dating back to 1698, the Cross Keys is one of the oldest pubs in Washington Village and located on a corner overlooking the picturesque village green. There is a beer garden and seating near the green. Close to the pub and the church lies Washington Village's Old Hall - a manor house dating from the 13th century, that was the home of the family of George Washington, the first president of the U.S.A.

CROWN & TRUMPET, Broadway, Worcestershire

This 17th century inn, built of mellow Cotswold stone, and complete with oak beams, log fires and a beer garden, stands just behind the green in the quintessential Cotswold village of Broadway. The village name refers to the wide, grass-fringed High Street, one of the longest in England, lined with mainly 16th century houses. The inn sign shows the Royal Herald with the trumpet that welcomes royalty.

THE INN AT ARDGOUR, Highland

This single-floor whitewashed stone lochside inn stands next to the Corran Ferry across Loch Linnhe, and provides stunning views across the water to the mountains beyond and the entrance to the Great Glen. Seals, otters, porpoises and dolphins have all been spotted nearby. Ardgour is situated at the Corran Narrows of Loch Linnhe, on the eastern side of the remote but beautiful Ardnamurchan Peninsula.

FALKLAND ARMS, Great Tew, Oxfordshire

This traditional 16th century Cotswold village pub gets its name from the 2nd Viscount Falkland, who owned the Great Tew estate in 1625. The picturesque village is at the heart of the parkland and farmland of the Estate, with charming thatched cottages, built of ironstone and gabled roofs. Inside the pub there are flagstone floors, ceramic jugs hanging from oak beams, and a cosy inglenook fireplace.
